*try this . . .*

Add the interesting texture of crumpled paper to your project with these effective tips:

- To crumple card stock, start at one edge and bend a portion back and forth between your fingers. Work your way across the sheet until the surface is completely crumpled.
- For a uniform look, dampen the card stock before crumpling. As it dries, it will become stiff.
- If you want to tear the edges or stamp the card stock, do it before crumpling.
